



Elegibility

Only United States citizens who are 18 years old can vote on Election Day.

Citizens of any county in the state who are not serving a felony conviction, and who have not been declared mentally incapacitated by a judge have the right to vote.

NOTES: If YOU ARE NOT a United States citizen, registering to vote or voting in the federal elections is considered a MAJOR CRIME.

Who can vote?



You only need to register once unless you change your address, name or marital status.



If you have not participated in last 3 years it is likely that you were removed from the voting patron and will have to register.



Each election has a deadline for registering new voters or making any other changes.











Registration Requirements

To register as a voter you must fill out and submit an application.

Provide one of the following documents:



Another identification with a photo issued by the government.

If you do not have any of these identifications, you can provide:

The last four digits of your social security number



Registration **Procedure**

Different methods to register to vote in Georgia:

Registration by mail (You can obtain a registration ballot in public libraries or schools)

Online Registration

Registration is available when you renew, or you apply for a driver's license.

College students can obtain a registration form from the registration office or the Vice President's Office of Academic Affairs.



If you are registering to vote by mail for the first time you will need a valid ID:



A copy of your current identification with photo.




Utility bill or a bank statement, government check or paycheck showing your current name and address.



Document issued by the government showing your current name and address (IRS).

Verification of Registration





Before contacting your county allow it at least 3 to 4 weeks.



Seal cards inform about voting location.
